If you donated \$5 to Secret Santa last year through Donato's Pizza, Budget Rent-a-Car or other sponsors and received a calendar featuring Central Ohio Police and Firefighter Heroes, then you may recognize one of our own as the September Honoree, **Sir Knight Dave Conley**, a detective with the Franklin County Sheriff's Office. Dave was appointed a Deputy in 1979 and served 15 years in uniform before moving on to the detective bureau for the past 8 years. There he investigates homicides and other difficult crimes including sexual predators, the darkest side of humanity one can ever see.

Dave became a member of our Assembly in June, 2001, as one of "The Cincinnati Six" from Council 4603 that I had the honor and privilege of proposing to the Patriotic Degree. You would recognize him as one of my best helpers at the hospitality suite earlier this year for the April Exemplification. After the cowards from the caves attacked, Dave went to NYC three different times to put his training and experience to work where it was needed the most, counseling and de-briefing police officers coming off their shifts at Ground Zero, sifting that rubble for human remains and belongings.

Even though Dave has his hands more than full at the detective bureau, he and Lady Sondra remain among the most active parishioners at O.L.P.H. He now serves as Deputy Grand Knight of Council 4603 and has agreed to help organize our Assembly's first Blue Mass honoring those who serve and protect us. Dave doesn't seek public recognition; he shies away from it, preferring to spend that time giving even more to the people and things that matter most. So when you see this HERO OF OURS, just give him your heartfelt thanks for being who he is and doing what he does.

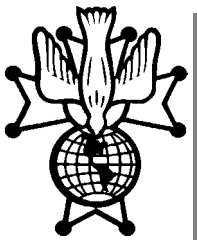
If all of us do this together in every time zone around the world, we will have a powerful chain of thoughts surrounding us.

Please tell all of your family, friends and neighbors to do this. Then by September 11, 2002, hopefully enough people will know about this and we can all join together in unity.

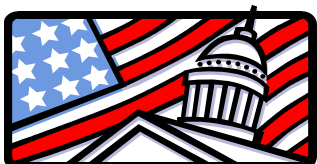
