A SPECIAL ELECTION to fill the office of Faithful Captain for the remainder of the current Fraternal Year (which ends June 30, 2003) will be held **on Thursday, February 20, 2003** as part of our Assembly's business meeting beginning at 8 pm. As Navigator, I announced- at our January 16, 2003 Assembly business meeting - my intention to have the Master declare that office vacant and sounded the first call for nominations according to the By-Laws of the Assembly and the Order. Faithful Pilot Jesus Garcia III was nominated at that time and he accepted the nomination. The final call for any other nominations will be sounded at the February 20th business meeting, and anyone nominated then who is present will be asked to confirm or decline acceptance of his nomination. Any nomination of a Sir Knight not then and there present will be ruled out of order. Once nominations are closed, the election will proceed. A majority of all votes cast is necessary to elect the Faithful Captain. If our Faithful Pilot is elected Captain, I will then again ask the Master to declare the office of Pilot vacant and repeat this same process for filling any such vacancy there. The Sentinels will be instructed to admit no one to this meeting who fails to first present them a valid 2002 or 2003 travel card from this Assembly AND their Council.

AN ELECTION OF DELEGATES TO THE DISTRICT ASSEMBLY for calendar year 2003 will also be held during the Assembly's business meeting **on Thursday, February 20, 2003**. As Faithful Navigator I am an ex-officio delegate and based upon our current membership, we are entitled to **three (3) additional delegates** beside myself. I will also call for the election of **two (2) alternate delegates** at that time to assure that a full four-member delegation is able to attend each and every District Assembly meeting the Master of the Southern District of Ohio may convene in 2003. Each Sir Knight voting will be allowed to vote for not more than three delegate and not more than two alternate delegate nominees on their individual ballot. The top three delegate and top two alternate delegate nominees receiving votes will be elected. This is a cumulative vote as a majority is not required.

Invoices for your calendar year **2003 Assembly dues (\$25)** and your Chalice Fund annual premium (**\$5**) are being sent by regular mail and electronic mail. Please pay this **\$30** to the Faithful Comptroller ASAP and get your 2003 travel card because if you let it go beyond 90 days, bad things can happen. Honorary Life Members are only required to pay a **\$6** Chalice Fund premium while Clergy Honorary Life Members, including Transitional Deacons, have no payment requirements to the Assembly.

REMEMBER there is still time to sign up for the February 8th PFN Dinner at DaVinci's. This nice evening out is **open to everyone**, not just PFNs and Assembly officers. Call me right away if you want to come.

Once again we are about to experience the most important event of our Fraternal Year. On **April 5th & 6th**, we will conduct the **Columbus Exemplification** of new Knights who wish to join our ranks in the **Fourth Degree**.

When I think back to my own Exempt, I remember it as being a memorable and impressive event. I'm sure that you remember your own Exempt in the same way. To create this memorable event requires a lot of hard work and expense. I know what you're thinking, "The candidates are paying for the Exempt". **Not entirely true!!** The candidate is charged \$65.00, from which the Master pays for his National Supreme Dues, his 4th Degree pin, his Social Baldric and his Saturday banquet meal. Other guests are paying \$30 for the banquet and \$15 for the Sunday brunch. The costs of those meals will use up about 98% of those fees. What that means is that there isn't anything left over to cover the costs of a first rate Degree team's expenses, the cost of meeting rooms for the Mass & Exemplification ceremony, the meals and expenses for the Bishop and other clergy members who attend, the meals and expenses for the Class Honorees, the guest speakers and the other distinguished guests who attend, the entertainment for the brunch and various other expenses that are inherent to presenting a first class Exemplification for the new candidates.

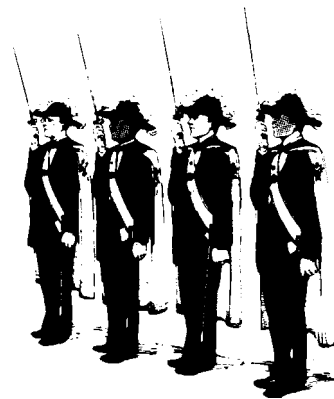
