These are all the extras that make for the kind of FIRST CLASS EXEMPLIFICATION CEREMONY that we've had in the past and should try our best to duplicate for the new incoming class of 2003.

These can come from your Council (who should be showing their support for their candidates), from a business you own or work at and from any merchant or organization that is willing support the Knights. The ads aren't expensive. They range from \$25 for a 1/4 page, to \$50 for a 1/2 page to \$100 for a full page. 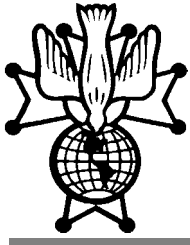
