I want to thank all my Brother Knights for supporting my election to Faithful Pilot & I hope you continue that support for the coming year.

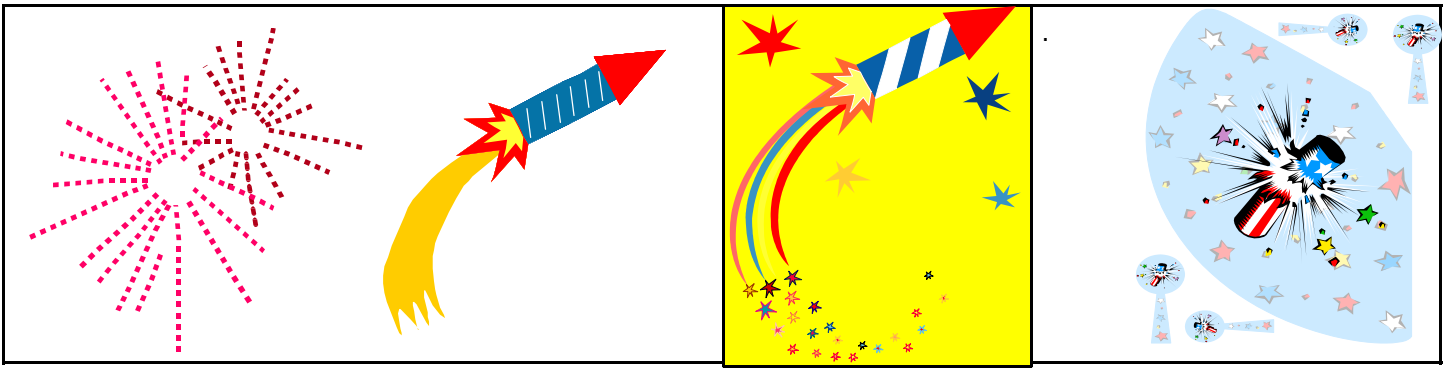
So far, it looks like July will be a quiet month:

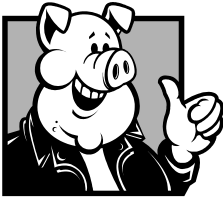

KERKMAN MEMORIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

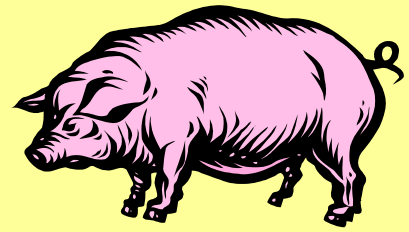

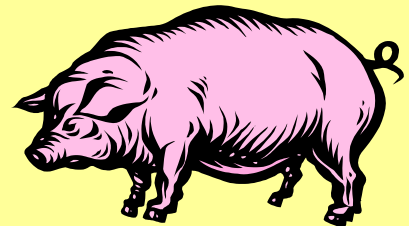

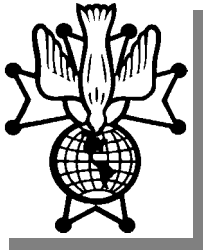
