This is your Assembly and these will be our officers. Come tell us how you want the Assembly run during the next year.

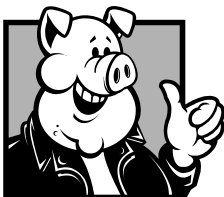

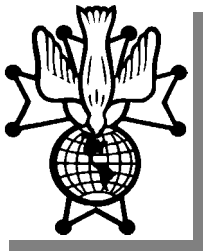
