If you are interested in being considered for nomination to any elected Assembly office, be sure to contact at least one of these committee members, if not all five. They will announce their nominations at the Assembly's **May 15<sup>th</sup>** business meeting. At that time and again at the **June 19<sup>th</sup>** business meeting, just prior to the balloting, **nominations can be made from the floor**. Only Sir Knights present at these meetings can be nominated so that they can accept or decline the same. I urge everyone, particularly new Assembly Members, to attend these next two meetings and participate in the election process. Please note, **only those Sir Knights of Assembly 809 with BOTH a valid Third and Fourth Degree Travel Card** will be admitted to these meetings. Offices to be elected are Faithful Navigator, Faithful Captain, Faithful Pilot, Faithful Admiral (only PFNs are eligible for Admiral), Faithful Trustee 3-year term, Faithful Scribe, Faithful Comptroller, Faithful Purser and Faithful Sentinels (Inner and Outer). Members of the Nominating Committee can also answer questions about the duties incumbent of these elected offices.

**PAY YOUR DUES!!!** To obtain the valid travel cards noted above, you need to be current on your Council and Assembly dues for calendar year 2003. If you have not paid either or both by now, you are delinquent and need to take care of that right away. **New Assembly Members** who Exemplified last month do not owe Assembly dues at this time. Our Assembly again waives its right to pro-rate and assess dues for 2003 to new Members both in gratitude for your having chosen this Assembly and also in recognition of the expense of your having done so. Our annual dues assessment is \$30 (\$25 general dues and \$5 to the Chalice Fund) and our Faithful Comptroller sends out Dues Statements in December.

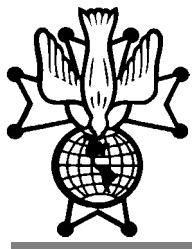

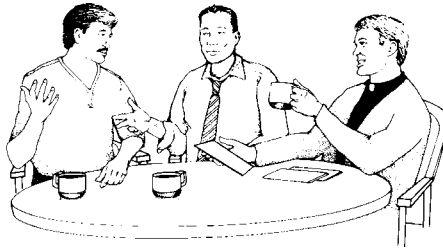

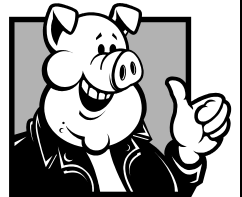
