- He also thanked Ralph Blamer, Pat Fahy and Tony Heger for being the honor guard for the mass at the District Deputies meeting at the Easton Hilton Jan, 11, 2004.
- Frank received a thank you note from seminarian Ty Thompson thanking the Fourth Degree Knights for their prayers, support and generosity for he and the other seminarians
- Frank asked that as many Knights as possible show up for the First Degree at the Pontifical College Josephinum.

F. Pilot's Report: Nothing to report.

F. Captain's Report:

- The Faithful Navigators' Ball is being postponed until May due to a lack of enthusiasm by this and the other assemblies that were invited. More information will follow in the newsletter and e-mails.

F. Comptroller's Report:

- Larry thanked everyone for the dues collected so far for year 2004. Approximately \$4000.00 in dues and chalice fund have been collected as of this date.
- Larry has received a bill for the chalices from Supreme. See "Reading of the Bills", above.
- As of the first of the year we had 296 members in Assembly 809. But, one member passed away in October 2003 unbeknownst to the Assembly and one member reinstated to the third degree, who was thought to have received his fourth degree but hadn't.
- The F. Navigator stressed that if we have any knowledge of one of our SK's passing, to contact the F. Pilot so he can assemble an honor guard for the funeral.
- Larry reported that he had been notified on January 13th that SK Joseph A Gallant passed away on October 4, 2003. No member of his family or his council notified us.

F. Purser's Report:

- Mark reviewed the assets and expenditures.
- A question was asked from the floor. Why aren't the monies from the golf fund transferred to the general fund since the purpose of the golf outing is to make money for the general fund. Answer. During this term of office, the disposition of the monies has not been formally allotted. There was a discussion. SK Bud Joos specified the various costs required to keep the golf outing going per year and agreed the net amount should go into the general fund.

Certificates will be given to the candidates that night if the information is given asap.

Sir Knights,

On page two of the December 31, 2003, of the *Knightline* newsletter is an article about supporting the “under God” phrase in the Pledge of Allegiance. As you know, certain factions are attempting to get the mandatory recitation of the Pledge declared unconstitutional.

Also, as you probably know, The Knights of Columbus were instrumental in having “under God” inserted into the Pledge. Do you know that we have been saying the Pledge wrong at the start of our meetings? You may have heard one of the Knights a beat or two ahead of everyone else at “one Nation under God.” That, fellow Knights, is me.

There was never meant to be a pause between “one Nation” and “under God.” It is meant to be one flowing thought or idea. Notice that when the Pledge is written, there is NO COMMA between these phrases. (A comma would indicate a pause.) Right now, say it both ways to yourself. See the difference? Without the pause, it says that we are, indeed, one Nation under God. Said with the pause, it seems to indicate that we are one Nation, oh, yeah, by the way, under God.

I’ve heard people say, “What difference does it make?” Well, I think it makes a lot of difference, especially to the members of the organization that led the effort to get the words inserted.

I know it’s hard to break a years-long habit (it was for me), but let’s try to recite the Pledge of Allegiance the way it was meant to be recited.
