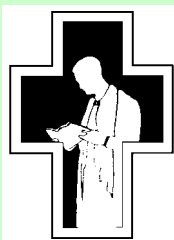

MINUTES OF THE FATHER HUBER ASSEMBLY 809 BUSINESS MEETING FOR 20 MAY 2004

Faithful Navigator Frank Polczynski called the scheduled 6:30 meeting to order at 7:05pm.

Roll call of the Officers. (present and excused): F. Friar (ex), F. Navigator, F. Captain, F. Pilot, F. Scribe, F. Comptroller, Inner Sentinel, 1st Yr. Trustee, 2nd Yr. Trustee, 3rd Yr. Trustee.

The meeting was declared open at 7:10pm.

F. Navigator's Report:

- Frank said this meeting was called for the nomination of Assembly Officers for the year 2004/2005.
- Frank said he had called two committee meetings of the Nominations Committee. No one showed up for either one so he is going to take nominations from the floor. This is a new by-law which Greg read last year, when he was the F. Navigator, that all elections are to be held in May. At this point in time the F. Navigator said he would like to close the meeting and reconvene at 8:00 pm. The request was seconded and approved.

- Frank read the (modified) article that he sent to the Columbia magazine about the Sunday afternoon reception the Assembly had hosted for the seminarians. The article is on page 28 at the lower left corner in the May 2004 issue.
