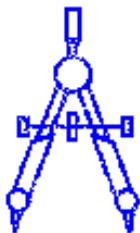

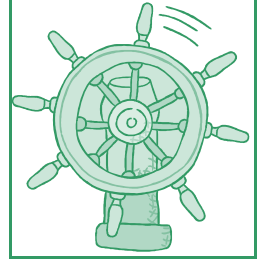

The ladies will have a **speaker** from **Estate Planning Professionals, Dave Lennox**, who will talk to us about planning for your future and retirement so that your money will be secure.

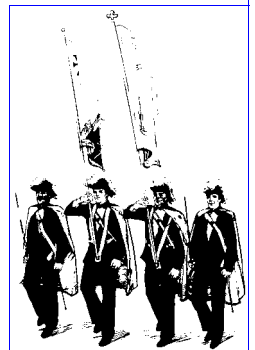

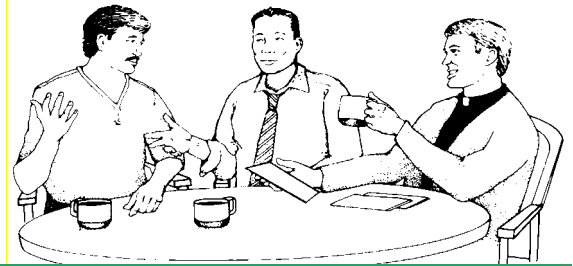
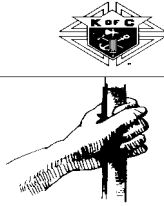
