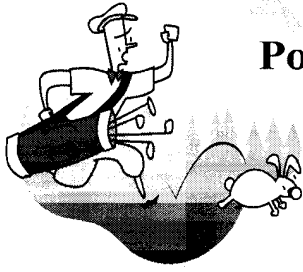

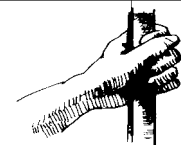

- Come and join us for an enjoyable evening.

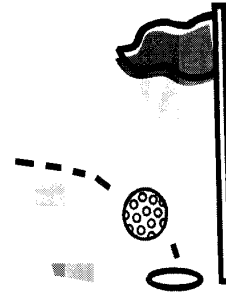
