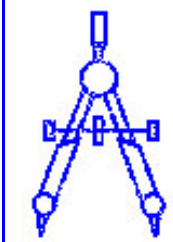

### The Captain's Corner

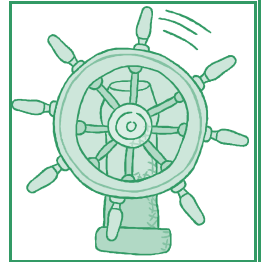
#### A word from Lady Charlene:

**June 12 - Father Carl Clagett Anniversary Mass**, Our Lady of Miraculous Medal, 2:00 PM, show time is 1:30PM

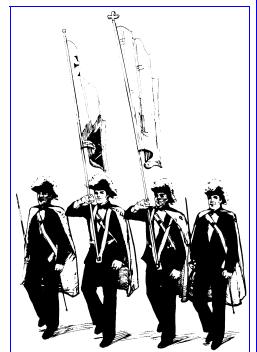

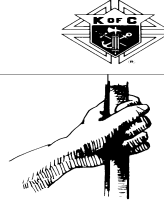
