The Shamrock Club will have a free ticket for the reunion for all that serve in the honor guard. The Annual Irish Reunion will take place at Vet's Memorial immediately following the St. Patrick's Day Parade. The Reunion hours are 1:00 PM until 7:00 PM.

St. Patrick's Day Parade is 17 March 2006

The Procession will form beginning at 9:00 AM on Rich St. in front of the City Center parking garage. It is suggested that all drivers of passenger vehicles that are not participating in the Procession, drop people off at the corner of High Street and Rich St. Then proceed to the Vet's Memorial parking lot. The shuttle bus will then take you back to the Procession staging area. The bus will start making runs at 8:00 AM and will continue until 9:15 AM. The cost for this service is \$1.00 per person.

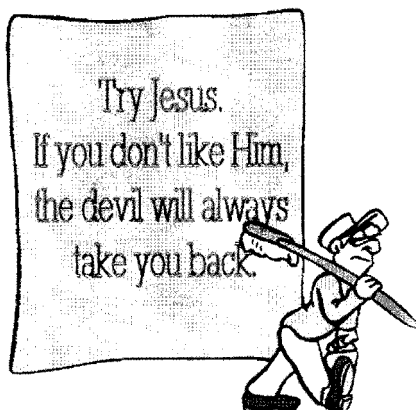
The Procession will step off at 9:30 AM and go east on Rich St. to Holy Cross Church. Mass will be celebrated at 10:00 AM.

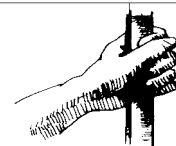

- **Bishop Frederick Campbell**, who holds a Ph.D. in History from the Ohio State University.
 - **Rev. Roch Kereszly**, O. Cist., international scholar, professor and author of his latest book *Wedding Feast of the Lamb: Eucharistic Theology from a Historical, Biblical and Systematic Perspective*.
 - **Rev. Paul Bernier, S.S.S.**, noted scholar, current editor of *Emmanuel* magazine, and author of several books including *Bread From Heaven, Bread, Broken and Shared* and *Eucharist: Celebrating its Rhythms in our Lives*.
 - **Sr. Gloria Therese**, O.C.D., who holds an M.A. degree in Moral Theology from Holy Apostle's Seminary and who currently works at the Franciscan University of Steubenville where she ministers to the 400 women who live on campus.
