Dinner from 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

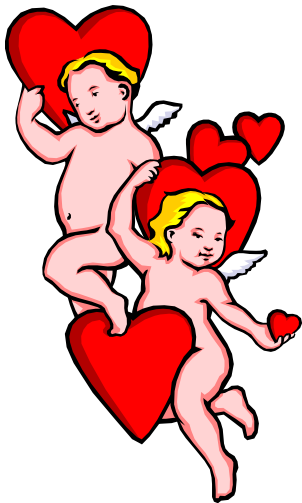
Band will start to play at 8:00 PM until 11:00 PM for those of you who would like to dance.

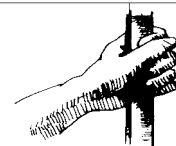

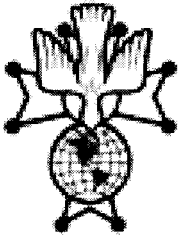
ASSEMBLY 809 MEETING'S TIME AND LOCATION
