1. Have a 4th degree meeting of the members of your Council before your regular meeting.
2. Make a list of non-4th degree members of your Council.
3. Make teams of two 4th degree members. Each team should take names of remaining Council members to approach for recruitment to the 4th degree.

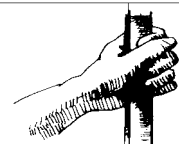

MEETING MINUTES

July 19, 2007 Meeting opened 8:00 P.M. by the Faithful Navigator.

Roll Call of the officers, present: Faithful Friar (Fr. John Bakle), Faithful Navigator (Al Cassady), Faithful Admiral (Ralph Blamer), Faithful Captain (Steve Skinner), Faithful Pilot (Charlie Sands), Faithful Comptroller (Mark Elam), Faithful Scribe (Ron Janning), Faithful Purser (Carl Emmenegger), Faithful Inner Sentinel (Jack Gookin), Faithful Outer Sentinel (Tom Huth), Faithful Trustee 3rd year (Don Divney).

Currently the Trustee 2nd year is not filled. Faithful Trustee 1st year (John Beckman) was absent from the meeting.

Reading of the Minutes: There were no corrections to the minutes and a motion was made to suspend the reading of the minutes and to accept them as published. The motion was seconded and passed with no discussion.

- **Special guest:** - Sister Barbara Catalano OP. – gave a presentation about the mission’s work that the Sisters of Mary are conducting in Eastern Africa. She asked us to consider giving money to their mission.
- **Friar’s Report:** He apologized for missing the installation of officers. Father Bakle also asked for prayers for the deacons that he’ll be instructing end of July, in Dayton, in the study of Mary, and in celebration for his forty years of being ordained. Father then went on to discuss the pope’s recent directive to reinstate the Latin mass, as presented in the missal of John XXIII. This was right before the 1962 council. As a result of that council it was encouraged that there should be full knowledgeable enlightened participation in the mass. The bishop encourages all to read the document, but cautions all priests to not to take action until he’s given it further study. There will be more communicated at the end of August. Father encourages us just to “sit tight” because change is going to be coming in the near future.
- **The following bills were read and referred:** – a bill submitted by Don Divney for supplies was read and a motion was made and accepted that the bill be submitted to the Trustees for their consideration.
- **Communication Read:** Dan Higgins’ letter was read, with regards to his stepping down.
- **Pilot’s Report:** 7/29 Holy Family and OLPH events, plus St. Augustine on 8/26. Please send your email addresses to Chuck at Charles_Sands68@Yahoo.com.
- **Captain’s Report:** Top of the Month (TOTM) dinner 8/6 at The Hickory House at 6:30 P.M.
- **Admiral’s Report:** 1st exemplification is in November. Rob DeSantos, first reading was given this evening. Ralph encourages all members to get together in their council meetings to bring others into the order.
- **Purser’s Report:** The report was submitted to the minutes.
- **Comptroller’s Report:** Sign-up sheet for officers. Mark is learning is responsibilities. He will contact Larry James to get back the Assembly’s laptop computer.
- **Scribe’s Report:** No report was given.

- **Trustee’s Report:** The audit was conducted on June 30th.
- **Unfinished Business:** Don Divney gave a report on his progress with his donations made for the Heart Walk; he’s still looking for more contributors.
- **4th Degree Master’s Report:** No report was given.
- **Patron’s Report:** No report was given.
- **Historian’s Report:** No report was given.
