In preparation for the Memorial Mass, I had to find out what Sir Knights still needed to be placed on the memorial. In doing so I had to find all the Directives that were filled out by the Sir Knights. Once I located them all, it became very clear that just like the Chalice fund, the name plate that you can request for the memorial needed to be looked at.

Per a motion from last meeting, I am re-writing the Directives to reflect that you may purchase a name plate for the memorial at a present cost of \$100.00. If the cost increases, so will your cost. The Assembly makes nothing off the name plates and the engraving company does this at their cost.

The language that states that you can donate your cape and chapeau to the Assembly will still be there without the clause "in lieu of".

Finally, the chalice fund was set up so that you would pay an extra \$5.00 with your dues to purchase a Chalice. Upon your death it would be engraved and given to a mission or you could give it to a church or priest of your choice. "Good idea back then". At the time the Chalice did not cost over \$300.00. With that at the present it will take you 60 years to buy your chalice.

This program is also being looked at. This program has been talked about for years. It will now be put on the table for some kind of action.
