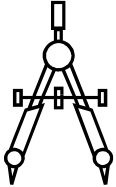

### **Flag Pole Memorial**

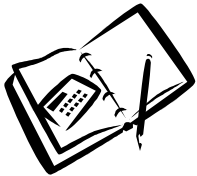
