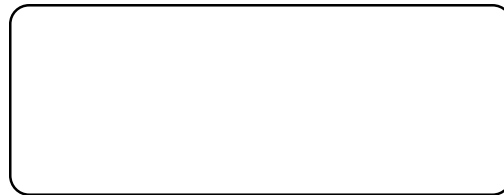

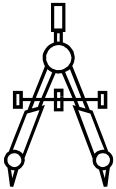

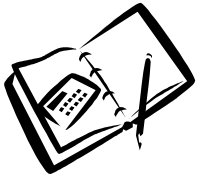

### **Remembering Our Deceased Brother Knights**

We all know the servant of God Father Michael J. McGivney founded our Order. He wanted to encourage Catholic men to preserve and develop in their faith.

He wanted to provide , through insurance, financial support for the widows of member and their children.

The fact that our Order is drawing close to its 125th anniversary next March is evidence of Father McGivney's vision, and the need for us to share his vision with more Catholic men in more communities and countries.

In rededicating ourselves to our Order's principles and purposes, it is important to recognize and honor the "fraternal giants" who went before us. In our Knights of Columbus tradition, we do this in a special way during November – the month set aside by the Church to pray for the souls of the departed.

Traditionally, on All Souls' Day, a special Mass of remembrance is offered at St. Mary's Church in New Haven. This is where Father McGivney founded our Order and where he is entombed. Our beloved brother

Knights, their spouses and Columbian Squires are recalled each day of the year at St. Mary's.

Every council is also encouraged to pray for the happy repose of the souls of our departed brothers, sometime during November, and at meetings throughout the year.

In this way, we recall our roots. We thank those who laid such a strong foundation for Columbianism. And we also pledge ourselves to act in such a way that the Knights of Columbus will continue and grow for generations yet to come.

### **Fourth Degree Emblem**

The triad emblem of the Fourth Degree features the dove, the cross and the globe. The dove, classic symbol of the Holy Spirit and peace, is shown hovering over the orb of the Earth (globe). Both are mounted on a variation of the Crusader's cross, which was found on the tunics and capes of the Crusading knights who battled to regain the Holy Land from the pagans. Spiritually, the sacred symbols on the emblem typify the union of the Three Divine Persons in one Godhead, the most Blessed Trinity.



- The Globe -- God the Father, Creator of the Universe.
- The Cross -- God the Son, Redeemer of Mankind.
- The Dove -- God the Holy Spirit, Sanctifier of Humanity.

The colors of the symbols are:

- A blue globe with the land of the Western Hemisphere in white.
- A red cross with gold borders and gold knobs at the end of the points forming the ends of the arms of the cross, also known as the Isabella cross.
- A white dove.

Red, white and blue are the colors of the flag of the country in which the Knights originated. They are used to stress patriotism, the basic principle of the Fourth Degree.

**Faithful Comptroller:**

The Columbian Martyrs Assembly, 4<sup>th</sup> Degree of the Knights of Columbus, has set aside an annual assessment for the purpose of presenting a memorial in the name deceased Sir Knights.
