

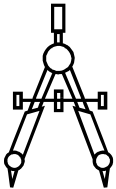

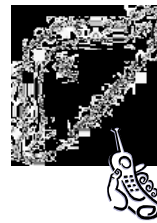
Sir Knights & Ladies:

Prayer composed by Bishop William E. Lori, supreme chaplain, for the Spiritual Pilgrimage with His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI on his Nov. 28-Dec. 1 pastoral visit to Turkey.

Heavenly Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth takes its name, we humbly ask that you sustain, inspire, and protect your servant, Pope Benedict XVI, as he goes on pilgrimage to Turkey – a land to which St. Paul brought the Gospel of your Son; a land where once the Mother of your Son, the Seat of Wisdom, dwelt; a land where faith in your Son's true divinity was definitively professed. Bless our Holy Father, who comes as a messenger of truth and love to all people of faith and good will dwelling in this land so rich in history. In the power of the Holy Spirit, may this visit of the Holy Father bring about deeper ties of understanding, cooperation, and peace among Roman Catholics, the Orthodox, and those who profess Islam. LOCATION:

Fourth Degree Exemplification at Cherry Valley in Newark, 17/18 March 2007. Rooms are available for \$99.00 per day. If you call for reservations, be sure to tell them you are with the Knights of Columbus. Fill out a K of C Form 4 and make a check out to K of C Assembly 2380 for \$70.00. The candidate is charged \$70.00, from which the Master pays for his National Supreme Dues, his 4th Degree pin, his Social Baldric and his Saturday banquet meal. Other guest meals will cost (estimate) \$35.00. This means that your wife or girl friend, as your guest, will cost an additional (estimate) \$35.00. On Sunday morning while you are busy, there is a Ladies Brunch at a cost of (estimate) \$15.00.

CANDIDATES' DRESS REQUIREMENTS: Black Tuxedo (no tails), White tux shirt with lay-down collar (no wing collar), Black bow tie & cummerbund, black socks, dress shoes, military baldric, white gloves & Knights sword (and purchase it from Supreme, Lynch & Kelly or The English Company) and your Third Degree Travel Card.

Saturday March 17th 10:00 am - 3:00 pm - Registration - Casual Dress-Candidates must present a paid up Third Degree member card at the time of registration, and present a sword & service baldric (labeled with his name and Assembly number).
4:00 pm - Mass - Candidates in full tuxedo.
6:30 pm - Banquet - Candidates in tux, wives in formal wear.

Sunday March 18th 7:00 am - 8:00 am – Hospitality Suite open for Continental Breakfast.

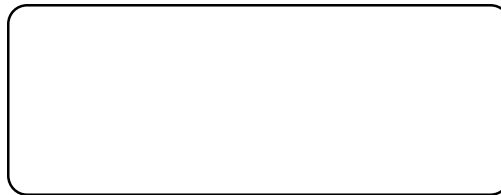
