

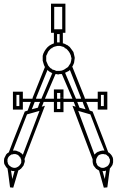

EXEMPLIFICATION CEREMONY

LOCATION: Fourth Degree Exemplification at Cherry Valley in Newark, 17/18 March 2007. Rooms are available for \$99.00 per day. If you call for reservations, be sure to tell them you are with the Knights of Columbus. Fill out a K of C Form 4 and make a check out to K of C Assembly 2380 for \$70.00. The candidate is charged \$70.00, from which the Master pays for his National Supreme Dues, his 4th Degree pin, his Social Baldric and his Saturday banquet meal. Other guest meals will cost (estimate) \$35.00. This means that your wife or girlfriend, as your guest, will cost an additional (estimate) \$35.00. On Sunday morning while you are busy, there is a Ladies Brunch at a cost of (estimate) \$15.00.

CANDIDATES' DRESS REQUIREMENTS: Black Tuxedo (no tails), White tux shirt with lay-down collar (no wing collar), Black bow tie & cummerbund, black socks, dress shoes, military baldric, white gloves & Knights sword (and purchase it from Supreme, Lynch & Kelly or The English Company) and your Third Degree Travel Card.

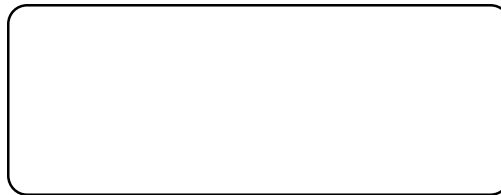
