

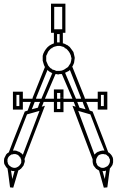

The month of April has many opportunities for you to serve and be a part of the Fourth Degree. Please support the Columbian Martyrs where you have the opportunity to serve.

The St. Francis Center has attempted to serve the needs of the people of Vinton County since 1979 as an **Outreach Center**. Anyone who is income eligible is able to participate with our programs for food, clothing, and shelter needs. The Center also responds to special needs when families are dealing with illness or death.

In 2006, the Center had 16,006 individuals, meaning 5,850 households who came to them for food. There were 6,174 from 1,818 households utilize their clothing center, and over 100 families who were assisted with furniture.

Throughout the year there are special programs for children and families. In 2006, those included;

- School supplies 582
- Socks and underwear 214
- Turkeys 325
- Christmas 699
- Easter 46
- Mother's Day 100

The Center's are true to the elements of the Appalachian Culture in that they draw more intensely upon values such as family, religion, humor, cooperation and personalism in order to survive. This background keeps them from being "pushy" and most experience a lack of self esteem.

The Center is experiencing the State and Federal Budget cuts in an extreme manner – their cupboards are bare. Right now it is difficult to fill the grocery bags and provide personal care items. To help St. Francis Center continue with their mission, **Solafide, a men's gospel quartet**, will be giving a concert at St Pius X Catholic Church, 1051 Waggoner Road, Reynoldsburg, Ohio. The **benefit concert** will be **Sunday**,

April 29th at 2 pm. A free will offering will be collected (admission is free).

Solafide has performed in churches and senior care facilities throughout central Ohio for about 8 years. Their blend of mostly a cappella gospel and spiritual music has been well received by these congregations. The members of the quartet are; Bill Bates from Gender Road Christian Church, Dave McKenney from St. Pius X Catholic Church, and Gary Henkel and Brian Schleppe are from Groveport United Methodist Church. These four men come from different backgrounds, but their united belief and faith in God is reflective in the message they give when singing.

Hope you can come and enjoy this concert in support of this very important mission.
