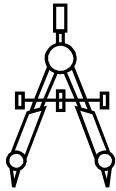

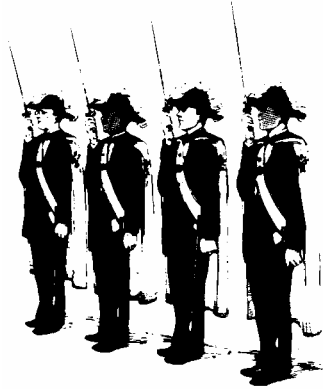
October Social Dinner

Memorial Mass

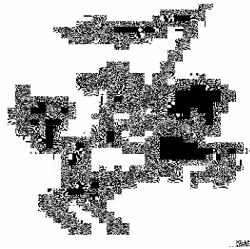

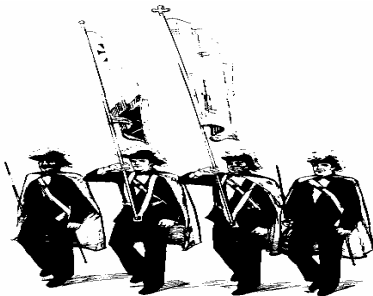
Forty-five members completed and have their directives on file. I don't plan on dying soon; however, my wife will feel more comfortable if she knows I completed the paperwork.
