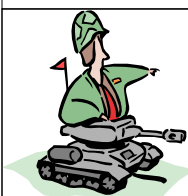
A big THANK YOU goes out to everyone who has participated. There was a good turnout for most everything.

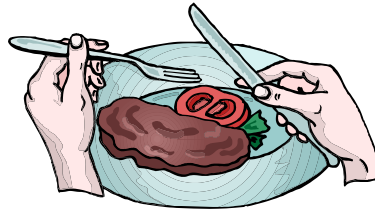
# LADIES PAGE

The combination of ingredients in this recipe produces a delicate sweetness that mingles perfectly with the steak. If you do not have honey in your pantry, you can successfully substitute brown sugar.

## MARINATED FLANK STEAK

Serves 4

2 cups hot strong coffee  
 ¼ cup honey  
 1 T ground ginger  
 1 T soy sauce



In a flat glass casserole dish combine the coffee, honey, ginger, and soy sauce. Place the meat in the dish and marinate in the refrigerator for 24 hours.

Remove the meat from the marinade and prepare a grill. Grill the meat on each side for about 5 minutes or place under the broiler for 10 minutes. Let stand 10 minutes before slicing.

Slice the meat on an angle in thin slices.

## LETTER WRITING CAMPAIGN

Since my husband Jon was diagnosed with hemochromatosis on July 17, 2006, I have been on a mission to learn more about the disease so I can support him. One thing I've learned is that hemochromatosis often goes undiagnosed or is misdiagnosed. I was inspired by a woman who is part of a listserv I'm on sponsored by the American Hemochromatosis Society; she wrote a letter to the editor for her local newspaper regarding this blood disease. I thought "what a great idea" and wrote a letter. I sent it to the Madison Press and the Columbus Dispatch but I decided that I needed to more. My primary goal is to submit my letter to all of the newspapers in the state of Ohio. At this time, I have submitted the article to approximately 15 newspapers but I have not yet seen my letter published. I have family in various areas of the state watching their newspapers for my letter so they can cut it out and mail it to me. A secondary goal that I have is to put together a scrapbook that documents Jon's hemochromatosis journey. If we confirm that Jon's hemochromatosis is hereditary, the scrapbook not only contains our memories but it can educate our son as he gets older. 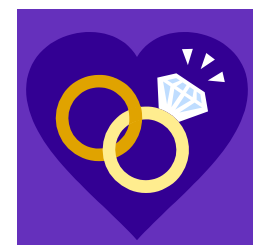
