Mapping out our Honor/Color Guard activities.

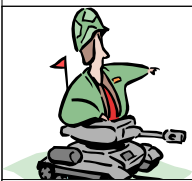

Heavenly Trifle

I created this dessert based off something I called an "Angelic Mess" which is similar except the pudding, cake, and whipped topping are all mixed together in a dish and served chilled.



This recipe is very flexible and you can make more or less based on the number of people you are planning to serve and the type of dish that you want to use. You can also experiment with different pudding flavors and different fruits. It looks really pretty when layered in a clear, tall dish.

- 1 small package sugar free cheesecake flavor pudding mix
- 1 8 oz. container lite whipped topping
- 2 1/2 C 1% milk (or whatever you have)
- 1 angel food cake (from the bakery department)
- 2 packages strawberries (from produce department)
- Cocoa powder for garnish

Prepare pudding by whisking the pudding and milk together and setting off to the side.

Slice one package of strawberries into your dish as your first layer. Pour about half of your pudding over top of the strawberries. Take half of the angel food cake and tear into pieces over top of the strawberries and pudding layers. Place half of the whipped topping carefully over top of the angel food cake layer. Slice another package of strawberries and place on top of the whipped topping layer. Tear the rest of your angel food cake and place over top of the strawberries. Pour the rest of the pudding over top of the strawberry and angel food cake layers. Carefully top with the rest of the whipped topping. Dust a layer of cocoa powder over the top for a nice finish.
