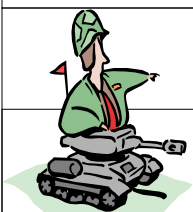
The cookie baking for Kairos at our November meeting was a great success. Thanks to the Ladies and Sir Knights for a fine effort!
