Mapping out our Honor/Color Guard activities.

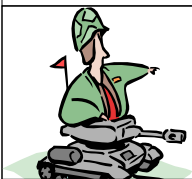

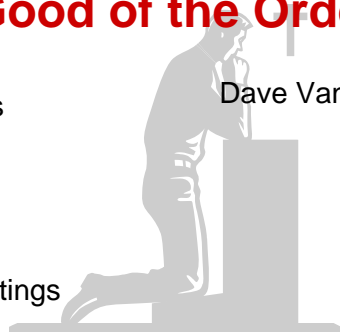
Commanding our Sir Knights in perfect step!

## Barbeque Ribs

Recipe from www.allrecipes.com modified by Jon Santini

*"This recipe is easier than it sounds. I usually cook the ribs the day before and grill them for a quick dinner the next night. FYI: the sauce is much better after it is cooked. It is not a dipping sauce."*

Prep Time: 15 min.

Cook Time: 2 hrs.

Ready In: 3 hrs. 15 min.

### INGREDIENTS

- 4 pounds pork spareribs
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup ketchup
- 1/4 cup soy sauce
- 1/4 cup Worcestershire sauce
- 1/4 cup rum
- 1/2 cup chile sauce
- 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1 dash ground black pepper
- 6 can of beer (your choice of what kind - try various kinds as it will change the flavor)



### DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Cut spareribs into serving size portions, place ribs in a large roasting pan with the beer, and bake for 1 1/2 hours.
2. In a bowl, mix together brown sugar, ketchup, soy sauce, Worcestershire sauce, rum, chile sauce, garlic, mustard, and pepper. Coat ribs with sauce and marinate at room temperature for 1 hour, or refrigerate overnight.
3. Preheat grill for medium heat. Position grate four inches above heat source.
4. Brush grill grate with oil. Place ribs on grill, and cook for 30 minutes, basting with marinade.

Note: You can also bake the ribs for 30 minutes for the final step, basting with sauce while cooking.
