**March 17 - St. Patrick's Day Parade** - Downtown. Formation will begin at 9 AM on Rich St. in Front of City Center Parking garage. It is suggested that all drivers of passenger vehicles that are not participating in the Procession, drop people off at the corner of High Street and Rich St. Then proceed to the Vet s Memorial parking lot. The shuttle bus will then take you back to the Procession staging area. The bus will start making runs at 8:00 AM and will continue until 9:15 AM. The cost for this service is \$1.00 per person. The Procession will step off at 9:30 AM and go east on Rich St. to Holy Cross Church. Mass will be celebrated at 10 AM. The Parade will form immediately after Mass. Upon leaving Church, please follow the directions of the Parade Marshals. The Parade will begin at 11:45 AM and proceed east on Rich St. to Grant Ave., north on Grant Ave. to Broad Street. It will continue west on Broad Street to Vet s Memorial where it will disband at approximately 1 PM.

## Irish Cream Bundt Cake

*Great tasting glazed Bundt cake with Irish cream baked in. Excellent for any time or any occasion*

Prep Time: 15 Minutes  
Cook Time: 1 Hour  
Total Time: 1 Hours, 30 Minutes  
Servings: 12

### Ingredients:

- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1 (18.25 ounce) package yellow cake mix
- 1 (3.4 ounce) package instant vanilla pudding mix
- 4 eggs
- 1/4 cup water
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 3/4 cup Irish cream liqueur
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/4 cup water
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1/4 cup Irish cream liqueur



### Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C). Grease and flour a 10 inch Bundt pan. Sprinkle chopped nuts evenly over bottom of pan.
2. In a large bowl, combine cake mix and pudding mix. Mix in eggs, 1/4 cup water, 1/2 cup oil and 3/4 cup Irish cream liqueur. Beat for 5 minutes at high speed. Pour batter over nuts in pan.
3. Bake in the preheated oven for 60 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the cake comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes in the pan, then invert onto the serving dish. Prick top and sides of cake. Spoon glaze over top and brush onto sides of cake. Allow to absorb glaze repeat until all glaze is used up.
4. To make the glaze: In a saucepan, combine butter, 1/4 cup water and 1 cup sugar. Bring to a boil and continue boiling for 5 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and stir in 1/4 cup Irish cream.
