May 6 - 1st Communion - St. Andrew's in Upper Arlington. Mass begins at 11:00 AM. Please be there by 10:30 AM.

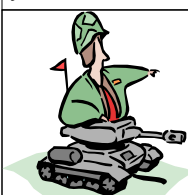
May 13 - Confirmation - St. Colman Parish in Washington C.H. Mass is at 5:00PM. Please be there by 4:30 PM.

Lemon Dijon Wings

"Delicious BBQ wings that are easy to make!"

Prep Time: 15 Minutes

Cook Time: 20 Minutes

Ready In: 2 Hours 35 Minutes

Servings: 4

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons coarse-grained Dijon mustard
- 6 cloves garlic, chopped
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1 tablespoon freshly ground black pepper
- 2 pounds chicken wings, separated at joints, tips discarded

DIRECTIONS:

1. In a large bowl, stir together the olive oil, lemon juice, mustard, garlic, salt, and pepper. Add chicken wings, cover, and marinate in the refrigerator for at least 2 hours, stirring occasionally.
2. Preheat grill for high heat. Drain marinade from chicken into a small saucepan. Bring to a boil, and simmer for 5 minutes. Set aside for basting. Lightly oil the grill grate. Grill wings for 10 to 15 minutes, or until juices run clear. Turn frequently and baste with the marinade during the last 5 minutes.

Note:

The nutrition data for this recipe includes information for the full amount of the marinade ingredients. Depending on marinating time, ingredients, cook time, etc., the actual amount of the marinade consumed will vary.
