## Balsamic Chicken & Peppers

*From the kitchen of Jodi Santini*

2 boneless, skinless chicken breasts cut into chunks  
1 bag (16 oz) tri-color peppers & onions (found in freezer section)  
Extra Virgin Olive Oil  
Balsamic Vinegar  
Your favorite seasoning (I used McCormick's Roasted Garlic grill mix)

Shredded cheese, if desired

In a large skillet, drizzle extra virgin olive oil to coat pan. Add chicken and lightly brown. Add the bag of peppers. Cover and simmer for about 10 minutes over medium heat stirring occasionally. Remove cover and add seasoning & balsamic vinegar to taste and simmer for 5 minutes or until pan juices are reduced. Sprinkle with shredded cheese, if desired.

This recipe is quite vague but it's something that I put together last week without any exact measurements except for 2 chicken breasts and a bag of frozen peppers. We served this with some rice on the side but you could choose bread, potatoes, or noodles.
