Crock Pot Pizza

From: *Country Kitchen Live with Connie Cahill* published by Kroger

2 or 3 jars	14 oz pizza sauce
1 box	12 oz bow-tie or wagon wheel pasta, uncooked
1 pound	sausage, cooked, drained, and crumbled
2 cans	8 oz stems & pieces mushrooms, drained
4 oz	sliced pepperoni
1 pound	bacon, cooked, drained, crumbled, or substitute real bacon bits
1	large onion, chopped
1 package	8 oz shredded mozzarella cheese
1/2 C	shredded mozzarella cheese

Spray crock pot with cooking spray. Layer half the pasta, 1 jar of pizza sauce, half the sausage crumbles, half the mushrooms, half the pepperoni, half the chopped onion, half the bacon then half the mozzarella. Start the next layer, using the rest of the pasta and pizza sauce and continuing with the remainder of the items. Add a cup of water. Cook on low for 5 to 6 hours. Sprinkle with remaining cheese before serving. Serves 8 to 10.



Notes: This recipe requires at least a 5 quart crock pot but could be cut in half for a small crock pot. You could also change or omit ingredients depending on what your family prefers on a pizza.
