Brother Sir Knights,

The Hennepin Province had their annual meeting in Perrysville on October 15 and 16. It was quite an impressive event with more than 200 Knight in attendance.

A new Vice Supreme Master, George Mallison, was installed along with our own Master, Francesco Iannaggi.

There were two topics of importance that were stressed during the meeting:

- 1) Due to the variety of lapel pins worn when in full regalia, only the lapel pin given to you when you became a 4th Degree Knight can be worn. Supreme is in the process of determining a new lapel pin with the appropriate flags. It is thought that the new pins will be sold at cost when they become available.
- 2) The second topic was one that we have discussed at previous Assembly meetings, and had been commented on by my predecessors. That is that the 4th degree is "A PART OF" not "APART FROM" the 3rd degree.

On October 25, the Master had a meeting of Navigators and Captains from 10 of the 12 Assemblies in the Columbus Diocese. The main topic was the Exemplification which will be held May 19 thru 21 2006 at the Hilton Hotel at Easton. The subject of a Degree team was discussed and anyone interested in participating in a speaking or non speaking part should let me know and I will get more information for you or put you in contact with someone with that information. It is anticipated that the Team will be functional for the Exemplification in Marietta in October 2006.

The other topic was the formation of a Color Corp that would be responsible for all Flag ceremonies at Exemplifications and other official functions. It is hoped that several members from each Assembly will be members of this Corp.

The Master is having a follow-up meeting on November 13 and I will report on that in the next newsletter.

Remember to participate in as many Council and Assembly activities as possible, with Veteran Day activities being a very important activity in November.

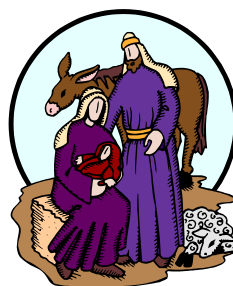
LADIES PROGRAM

Original recipe yield: 2 - 9x5 inch loaves.

Ingredients:

3 cups all-purpose flour
5 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
2 teaspoons baking soda
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
3 cups granulated sugar
1 (15 ounce) can LIBBY'S® 100% Pure Pumpkin
4 eggs
1 cup vegetable oil
1/2 cup orange juice
1 cup fresh or frozen cranberries



Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease and flour two 9 x 5-inch loaf pans.
2. Combine flour, pumpkin pie spice, baking soda and salt in large bowl. Combine sugar, pumpkin, eggs, vegetable oil and orange juice in large mixer bowl; beat until just blended. Add pumpkin mixture to flour mixture; stir just until moistened. Fold in cranberries. Spoon batter into prepared loaf pans.
3. Bake for 60 to 65 minutes or until wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pans on wire racks for 10 minutes; remove to wire racks to cool completely.
