Full Regalia Functions

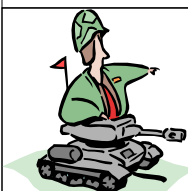

Serves 8

Spicy sausage is browned, then cooked in a slow cooker with olives, tomato sauce and beans in this easy chili flavored with soy sauce.

Ingredients

3 pounds ground spicy pork sausage

2 cups chopped onion

3 (15 ounce) cans tomato sauce

3/4 cup water

1/2 cup chopped black olives

1/2 cup chopped green olives

1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper

1 tablespoon soy sauce

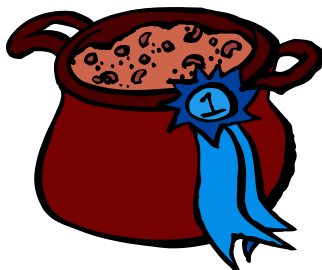
2 teaspoons chili powder

1 (15 ounce) can kidney beans

Preparation

1. In a large skillet over medium-high heat, cook sausage until brown. Drain and crumble.

2. In a slow cooker, combine sausage, onion, tomato sauce, water, black and green olives, pepper, soy sauce, chili powder and beans. Cover and cook on low 8 hours.
