Brother Sir Knights,

The Hennepin Province of the 4th Degree had Ohio split into two Districts, the Northern and Southern Districts. Recently a Central District was formed that included the Dioceses' of Columbus and Steubenville. We are now part of that Central District.

There are 17 Assemblies in the Central District with 12 in the Columbus Diocese, and 4, including ours that are located in Franklin county, even though we have member Councils in other Counties. On Tuesday September 27, the four Franklin County Navigators met with Master SK Frank Iannaggi to discuss matters relating to the new District.

The next Exemplification we will have in Columbus will be on May 20 and 21 at the Hilton at Easton. As a new District, our Master is creating our own Degree team. This will consist of approximately 13 people. There are 4 speaking parts with the remainder of the team as support staff. If you are interested in participating as a member of the Degree team or want additional information, please let me know. This is an excellent way to participate in a 4th Degree Activity.

Another very important part of the Exemplification is the ad book that is used to fund the Exemplification and keep the cost to participants at a minimum. I ask you to get your Council to take an ad and to get members who own retail businesses to do so also. This book goes to several hundred people in the Central Ohio area.

Each Council should set a goal of having at least two members become 4th Degree Knights. Over time this will provide each Council with a sufficient number of members to provide and Honor Guard for all Communions, Confirmations, and other important Parish activities.

There are two very important activities that the 4th Degree participates in that require as many knights in full Regalia as possible. These are the Parade at the Pumpkin Festival in Circleville and the Veteran's Day Parade. More detail will be sent to you later.

Remember to participate in as many Council and Assembly activities as possible.

German Potato Cheese Soup

A rather rich soup, but very delicious. It contains three types of cheese - Cheddar, Swiss, and processed cheese food.

Servings: 12

Ingredients:

- 4 cups water
- 2 1/2 cups chicken broth
- 4 tablespoons chicken soup base
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 2 large carrots, finely chopped
- 4 potatoes, peeled and diced
- 1 large onion, diced
- 2 stalks celery, finely chopped
- 1 red bell pepper, diced
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 8 ounces processed cheese food (eg. Velveeta)
- 1 cup shredded sharp Cheddar cheese
- 1/2 cup shredded Swiss cheese
- 1/4 cup dry potato flakes

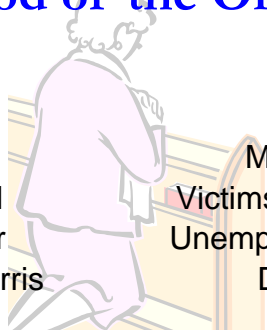


Directions:

1. In a large stock pot, combine water, chicken broth, chicken soup base, black pepper, carrots, diced potatoes, and onions. Bring to a boil, and then reduce heat. Simmer 15 minutes, or until vegetables are tender, stirring occasionally.
2. Add celery and red bell pepper, and simmer for 5 minutes.
3. Gradually add mayonnaise to hot soup, whisking until smooth. Reduce heat to medium low. Gradually stir in processed cheese, sharp Cheddar cheese, and Swiss cheese; continue stirring until cheese melts, about 5 minutes.
4. Mix in potato flakes. Remove from heat, and let sit for 15 minutes before serving.
