If you have a candidate that will be going through the Exemplification on Nov. 10, in Lancaster, Ohio, the following must be met. Third Degree Members of the order for six months or more (but less than one year) for this Exemplification the Candidate must have received the Honor of the First Degree on or before May 10, 2007. They may apply in writing to the Master for a waiver request form if they haven't met the above. The Master will forward the request to the Supreme Master for approval. The waiver request must contain the necessary information, and must be received on or before Sept 24, 2007 in order to allow time for processing.

Any waiver request received after Sept 24, 2007 must be accompanied by check for \$ 28.80 to cover processing and handling fees, made out to Columbus 4th Degree Exemplification Fund and there is no guarantee that the waiver will be granted or processed in time for the Exemplification.

All form 4's must be received by District Executive Secretary by Oct. 15, 2007, along with registration forms.

All moneys must be received by the District Executive Secretary by Oct. 29, 2007

As always, keep an eye on the calendar for upcoming events. It's kind of tough to be a Commander if there is no one to Command!

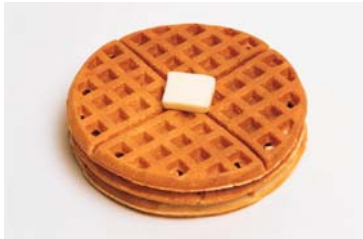

Classic Waffles

INGREDIENTS

2 cups all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon salt
4 teaspoons baking powder
2 tablespoons white sugar
2 eggs
1 1/2 cups warm milk
1/3 cup butter, melted
1 teaspoon vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS

In a large bowl, mix together flour, salt, baking powder and sugar; set aside. Preheat waffle iron to desired temperature.
In a separate bowl, beat the eggs. Stir in the milk, butter and vanilla.
Pour the milk mixture into the flour mixture; beat until blended.
Ladle the batter into a preheated waffle iron. Cook the waffles until golden and crisp. Serve immediately.

Notes from the Santini Kitchen:

Our son absolutely loves these waffles! I made them for Jonnie one weekend while Jon was away. Our waffle maker makes waffles like the ones show in the picture. I took each quarter and cut it into slices so that Jonnie could dunk the slices into a small dish of syrup. The only thing I could get him to eat for breakfast, lunch, and dinner that Sunday were these waffles. The only ingredient change I made was that I used extra virgin olive oil instead of the melted butter. The waffles are crisp on the outside and tender inside. If you have extras, they reheat nicely in the toaster.
