A big THANK YOU goes out to everyone who has participated. There was a good turnout for most everything.

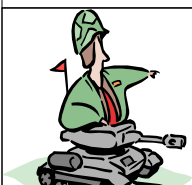
Full Regalia Functions

Cost: \$5.00 ea.

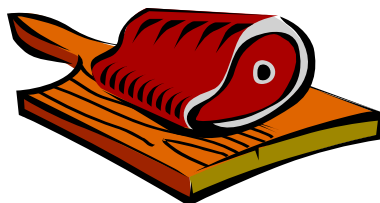
Material: Six to eight photographs and roller tape

Cuban Ropa Vieja

Ingredients:

- 1 T vegetable oil
- 2 pounds beef flank steak
- 1 C beef broth
- 8 oz tomato sauce
- 1 small onion, sliced
- 1 green bell pepper, seeded & sliced into strips
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 6 oz tomato paste
- 1 T ground cumin
- 1 T chopped fresh cilantro
- 1 T olive oil
- 1 T white vinegar

Directions:

Heat vegetable oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Brown the flank steak on each side, roughly 4 minutes a side.

Transfer beef to slow cooker. Pour in the beef broth and tomato sauce, then add the onion, bell pepper, garlic, tomato paste, cumin, cilantro, olive oil, and vinegar. Stir until well blended. Cover, and cook on High for 4 hours or low for up to 10 hours. When ready to serve, shred meat and serve with tortillas or rice.

Notes from the Santini Kitchen:

We made this dish and wanted to share our lessons learned. The mixture will be very wet after cooking all day. This made quite a mess even when using a slotted spoon to put meat into wheat tortillas. We want to try this again with less liquid. We were also expecting more flavor but we found it quite bland when prepared as above. When we make this again, we plan to add some diced hot pepper and/or a packet of taco seasoning depending on what we have in the pantry. The meat is nice and tender and shreds nicely.
