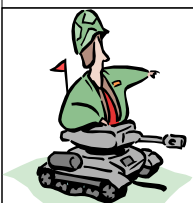

Of Interest...

Ginger Steak

- 4 8-oz beef sirloin steaks about 3/4 inch thick
- 2 T soy sauce
- 1 T ground ginger
- 1/2 t salt
- 1 t ground black pepper
- 1 t dried basil
- 1 T prepared yellow mustard
- 1 T lemon juice



Combine all ingredients in a small bowl except for the steaks. Pour marinade over steaks using a glass or plastic container. Marinate steaks for 2-4 hours so they soak up the flavors.

Heat grill of your choice and cook steaks to desired doneness.

Notes from the Santini Kitchen: When Jodi made the marinade she used ginger puree from a tube instead of ground ginger and Italian seasoning instead of just basil. She also omitted the salt since soy sauce can be salty.

What goes great with steak? How about potatoes?

Dijon-Roasted Potatoes

- Non-stick cooking spray
- 1 t olive oil
- 2 T Dijon mustard
- 3/4 t paprika
- 1/4 t dried thyme
- 1/2 t salt
- 1/4 t black pepper
- 1 1/2 pound potatoes, cut in large dice



Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Coat 9x13 pan with cooking spray.

In a large bowl, whisk together oil, mustard, paprika, thyme, salt, pepper; add potatoes and stir to coat.

Transfer potatoes to prepared baking dish and roast 15 minutes; stir and roast until tender on inside, about 15 to 20 minutes more. Yields 4 servings.

Notes from Santini Kitchen: Jodi used Italian seasoning instead of just dried thyme. For the salt & pepper, Jodi used a 1/2 t of garlic pepper salt.
