Our Knights of Columbus has been and will continue to be strong champions for those God-given values.


The lives of the unborn, nearly one and half million killed per year, have been left out

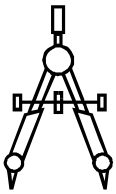
of this God-given right. There can be no liberty or pursuit of happiness without life.

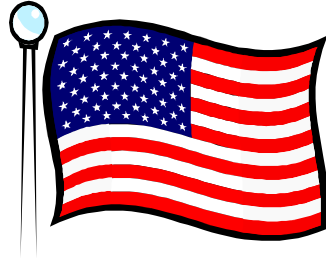
