#### **Marysville Council 5534 – Last Month's Happenings**

We concluded the annual Lenten Fish Fry Dinners with a final profit (revenue less expenses) of over \$5,700. We served over 200 meals each of the six Friday evenings, and while we did not have any night when we served over 300 meals, we did not have any evenings when we failed to break 150 meals. Hence, attendance was constant each night - a first for the council since holding these fish fry dinners over at the Catholic Community Center. After setting aside monies to give back to the parish and to the Venture Crew (as we have always done), we hope to continue other charitable donations that we started last year, such as giving a student a \$500 college scholarship and allowing a youth currently detained at the Central Ohio Youth Center to take the GED test by paying for the test fee.

Finally, on behalf of the council, I would like to congratulate our newest members to the council, Darrin McWhorter and Rich Marquis. Both are active with the parish' scout troops. Darrin also helps with the PSR program, while Rich is one of the new members of the parish's adult choir. Please make Brothers Darrin and Rich feel welcome in our council. We surely could use their talents in helping us come up with more activities that would help us put into practice our motto of "In Service to One, In Service to All." I would also like to thank Brother Knight Brad Blumberg and Brother Sir Knight Randy Ralston for their efforts in recruiting our newest Brother Knights. Of course, I would also like to thank Brother Knight Mark Meyer and Brother Sir Knight Randy Ralston for accompanying Darrin and Rich to the First Degree at St. Joan of Arc in Powell last April 26<sup>th</sup>. We hope to bring Morgan Cotter to a First Degree in May 2011.

The month of May will prove to be quite a busy month for the council. It starts with the council meeting on May 5<sup>th</sup>. The council will host its annual Mother's Day Breakfast for the parish at the CCC gym on Sunday, May 8<sup>th</sup>. The following Monday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, the council will assist the scouts with the annual mulching around the parish grounds. Brother Knights are also welcome to consider praying with our Lord in the Presence of the Blessed Sacrament from Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, through Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, during the monthly Adoration. This Adoration concludes with the Knights Hour starting at 9 a.m. on Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup> and concludes with Benediction at 10 a.m. The council will also hold its first KofC Extravaganza at the hall on Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. On Wednesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, Brother Knights are requested to also be present at the cemeteries to help place flags by tombstones in preparation for the Memorial Day celebrations. We will also host our annual Graduates' Breakfast at the CCC gym on Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, starting at 10 a.m. Then, the council is also asked to support the Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen Assembly 3157 as it participates in the Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. The first litter pick-up for the Adopt-A-Highway program activity is also being scheduled for the first couple of weeks of May. ### Council Brothers observe Stations of the Cross devotion

Following a short business meeting on April 12, Deacon Tony Bonacci, assisted by Brother Ed Stransky, conducted Stations of the Cross devotion in the church for attending Brothers. We plan to make this a Lenten tradition in the coming years.



### Best-ever Lenten Fish Frys draw many from outside the community

Our Council 12772 Lenten Fish Frys ended on a high note on April 15 when 238 meals were served. That evening concluded a 6-week run of decent weather during which a total of 1513 fish dinners were dealt out to hungry guests. Another record set in the prior week was the 290 meals served on a single night.

Our fish-squeezing Brothers should note that this amounted to over 3,100 Alaskan Pollock fillets squeezed - an average of over 500 per week!

Not only are parishioners turning out to support our effort, but we had quite a few dining visitors from outside the Plain City community. One group of 17 from a Hilliard condo development (neighbors of the Hess's) enjoyed themselves so much that 11 of them returned the following week. Said one discerning member of this group, "It was the best fish I have ever eaten!"

Some 30 dedicated Knights worked the 6 events, making the Fish Frys the best-supported activity of the 36 projects our Council completed in the past year.

One improvement implemented this year in the final two Frys was Lady Lisa Hess serving as a spotter to guide the dinner servers to their correct table, thus speeding the delivery process.

A net profit of over \$6,000 will enable our Council to continue implementing the various projects throughout the coming year for our Council, our Parish and our Community.
